



LAY OUTREACH & DEVELOPMENT WORKER

The Wirral Methodist Circuit is seeking to appoint a committed Christian as lay worker to work at Moreton Methodist Church, Pasture Road, Moreton CH46 7TT.

The mission of the lay worker will be to work with church volunteers and ecumenical partners in their outreach to the local community, especially where there is social and economic disadvantage. There are existing activities to be encouraged and built-upon as well as new opportunities and relationships to be discerned and developed.

The working hours will be 20 hours per week to be agreed with the line manager and will involve some evening and weekend working. These will include Wednesday mornings and Friday afternoons.

The appointment will initially be for a three-year term with a salary in the range £21,000 to £24,000 full-time equivalent depending on experience and achievements. This will mean a range of £11,200 to £12,800 for the 20 hours.
